Driver Education

The Link offers Driver Education training for students age 15 years by June 25th. **Classes after July 1, 2010, students must be 15 yrs 6 months.** Initially offered only in Fayette County, the Link has expanded its driver training program to eight surrounding area schools. Connersville and Richmond offer the course in the fall, spring, and summer. Centerville and Hagerstown offer the course during the spring and summer, while Union County, Northeastern, Lincoln, and our latest school program, Rushville, all offer summer classes.

Fall and Spring sessions: after school

Summer: 8:00 a.m.–6:00 p.m.

Class fees in all counties is \$385.00

The typical Driver's Ed class includes:

- ♦ 30 hrs class time – 15/2hr classroom sessions
- ♦ 6 – 12 hours observation time
- ♦ 6 hours drive time

Once I sign my student up to take the course, what do I need to do to get his/her permit?

You will need to take the following items to the license branch:

- ♦ Pink Slip
- ♦ One document proving your lawful status in the United State, i.e., Birth Certificate (Original - No Copies & No Hospital Certificates)
- ♦ Social Security Card
- ♦ One document proving your identity, i.e., School ID Card or Picture ID
- ♦ 2 documents proving your Indiana residency

Summer driver education students experienced what it would be like to drive at night and also drive under the influence of alcohol or drugs.



With the supervision of the Wayne County Sheriff's department, students drove golf carts around the Connersville High School parking lot while wearing goggles that simulate night vision and driving while under the influence. Students also navigated their way through an obstacle course laid out using orange cones in an attempt to keep from knocking down cones.

Driver training uses textbooks and actual behind-the-wheel driving time with a certified instructor. All instructors are licensed with Driver Education Endorsements by the Indiana Bureau of Motor Vehicles. This program is licensed by the state, but this class is not for high school credit. A waiver is given to students who qualify.
